## \* Broiler :-

A broiler is any chicken (*Gallus gallus domesticus*) that is bred and raised specifically for meat production most commercial broilers reach slaughter weight between four and seven weeks of age although slower growing breeds reach slaughter

weight at approximating breed reach slaughter weight at approximately 14 weeks of age

\* Typical broilers have white feathers and yellowish skin Broiler or sometimes broil is also used sometimes to refer typically to younger chickens under 2.0 kilograms (4 lb) as compared with the larger roasters

## \* Lay chicken :-

Lay chicken poultry farming means raising egg laying Poultry bird for the purpose of commercial egg production. Layer chickens are such a special species of hens, which need day old. They remain laying eggs continuously till their 72 - 78 weeks of age.

They can produce about one kg of egg by consuming about 2.25 kg of food during their egg laying period for the high egg production breeds available through the world.

## \* Caring Broilers :-

Broilers are young chicken of either sex to week old tender meat with soft pliable smooth skin and breast bone cartilage

## \* Housing :-

Provide 920 young chicken of either sex of six weeks of age tender meat with good ventilation The general management of broiler is similar to those under egg type chicks

## \* Feeding :-

Provide up to 2 weeks 85 cm and from  
 Raise if tube feeders are used Provide nos  
 of 1/2 kg Capacity feeders per 100 chicks
